

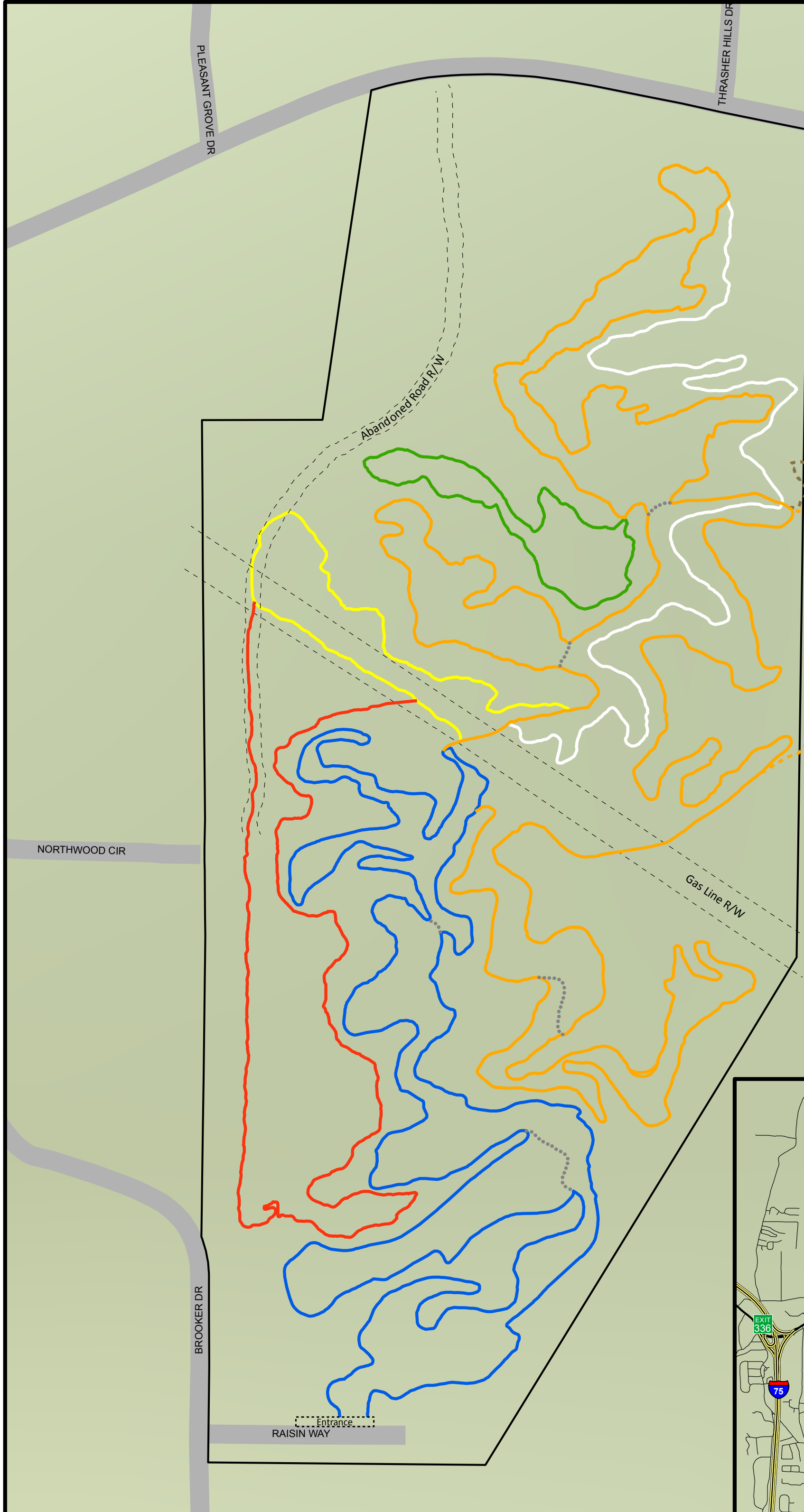
Raisin Woods Mountain Bike Park
